THE DEPARTMENT

The Reedsport Police Department employs 14 full-time staff, several part-time staff and volunteers. This includes, a Chief, Sergeant, Corporal, a Communications/Records Supervisor who is also the Chief's Administrative Assistant, six Police Officers, including one School Resource Officer and four Communications Officers. Included within the department is a correctional facility and a 24-hour dispatch center.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Must be 21 yeast of age; high school diploma or GED; valid driver license or able to obtain; no felony criminal record; no excessive traffic violations; U.S. citizen.

Applicants must pass a background investigation, psychological exam, a hearing exam, eye exam and physical exam.
